

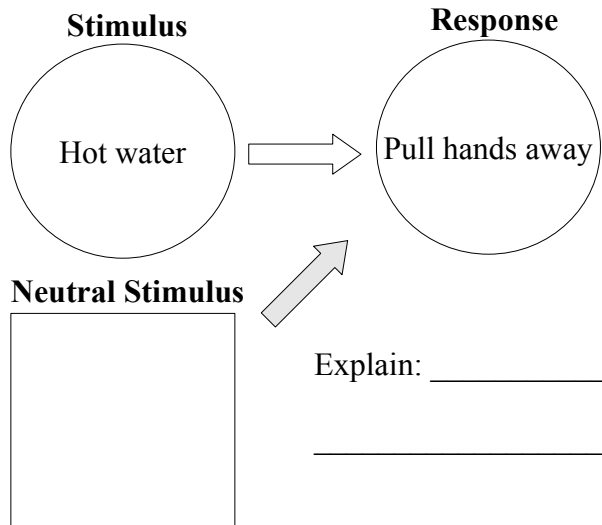

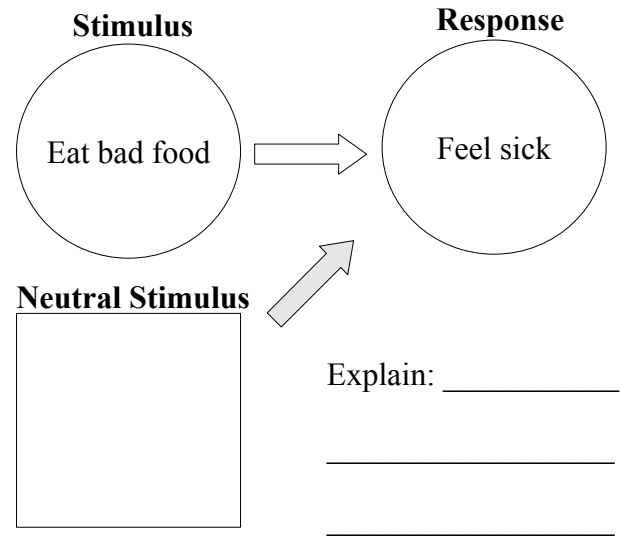
A. Write a neutral stimulus in the rectangle that can be conditioned to cause the response.

B. Explain how the neutral stimulus can be conditioned to cause the response.

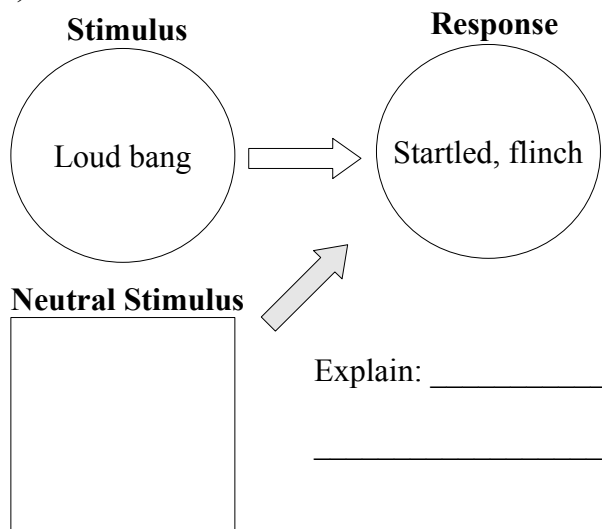
